

Established in 1977, the Cultural Consortium of the Territory of Monfalcone (CCM) consists of the municipalities of Fogliano Redipuglia, Monfalcone, Ronchi dei Legionari, Sagrado, San Canzian d'Isonzo, San Pier d'Isonzo, Staranzano, and Turriaco, as well as the Land Reclamation Consortium of the Isontina Plain.

Since its founding, the Consortium's main areas of activity have been historical research, the enhancement of cultural heritage, the promotion of reading and library services, and the preservation of the photographic heritage.


For years, CCM has collaborated with schools, associations, and organizations to carry out educational activities, cultural events, exhibitions, and publishing initiatives.


Special attention is given to the promotion of Slovenian culture and language, considering the significant presence of the linguistic community in some of its municipalities.


More recently, the Consortium has been involved in tourism promotion, particularly within the Ecomuseum "Territories. Peoples and Memories between Karst and Isonzo."

The Memory Archive



The Consortium researches, collects, and preserves documents related to the history of the Monfalcone area: documents, publications, diaries, letters, objects, audio and video recordings, as well as poetic and artistic works, donated or loaned by public entities and private citizens.

Thanks to the materials from the Archive of Memory, the **Monfalcone Shipbuilding Museum** has been established.

The Photographic Archive



The Photographic Archive, active since 1977, collects photographic material from private collections and family archives related to the cultural identity and socio-economic, urban, and industrial development of the area.

After more than 40 years of research, the archive contains approximately 65,000 photographs, including glass and film negatives, as well as prints on paper and film from various periods, starting from the early 1900s. The collection is divided into 106 fonds and is continually growing thanks to donations from organizations and private citizens.



The Specialized Library



The library of the Monfalcone Cultural Consortium has been active for forty years, primarily focused on the collection and preservation of documents of local interest and in the sectors in which the organization specializes, particularly:


- Local history and culture

It will be a stimulating, beautiful, and welcoming place with a rich program of activities.















The CCM manages the Library System of the Province of Gorizia, BiblioGO! (Regional Law 23/2015).


- 23 Municipal Public Libraries


















SLOVENIAN DESK









CCM EDITIONS

The Consortium's editorial catalog has progressively grown and now offers a wide range of monographic volumes on history, economics, literature, poetry, photography, art, and architecture.

Among these, the poetry series in the Bisiaco dialect, "Farina Fina," and the memorial series "Memorie" stand out for their continuity, allowing the history of Bisiacaria to be told from the perspective of its protagonists.

From 1978 to 2003, the magazine "Il Territorio" accompanied the development of the area, serving as a reference point for cultural debate, with historical, artistic, and architectural insights, articles on photographic enhancement, and discussions of the traditional and characteristic features of the Isontino.

Today, the magazine is available in digital format in the section "Il Territorio" and from 2024 is back with an online version.



Villa Vicentini Miniussi: A Project for Enhancement



With the opening of the new Heritage Conservation Center, the Villa will finally be cleared of the cultural assets it holds: books, documents, works of art, and photographs.


This will allow for the development of a project to enhance the Villa with a redistribution of spaces.

In 2024, a new project has been launched, already funded by the Region through a PR FESR 2021-2027 initiative aimed at supporting cultural operators to promote the use of ICT solutions and augmented reality.

This will help establish an immersive museum and a digital space within the Villa to narrate the history of the area from a tourism and cultural perspective, promoting the cultural heritage of the entire region.

It will serve as a gateway to the Bisiacaria.

The library will be redesigned to create a shared space for the community, to be called the Library of Cooperation.





Heritage Conservation Center



Thanks to regional funding, we are building a new facility in Ronchi dei Legionari that will house the collections of the CCM as well as the bibliographic heritage of the Consortium members and affiliated entities in the province of Gorizia.

In 2025 will be launched the project for transferring here the historical archival heritage of the municipalities, called ArchiGO!.

With the new center, Villa Vicentini Miniussi will be fully enhanced, reclaiming its role as a museum and exhibition space, a place for cultural meetings and exchanges.
